## INSPECTIONS

All Entries will be inspected for soundness prior to running each event. In addition, all bitches will be checked for being in-season. INSPECTION MAY NOT BEGIN PRIOR TO PUBLISHED TRIAL HOURS.

### ROLLING INSPECTION & EXHIBITOR BRIEFING

A briefing for exhibitors will be held prior to running the CAT test. For efficiency and to accommodate conflicts, a rolling schedule may be implemented. Exhibitors should check in and advise the Field Chair of conflicts.

### COURSING ABILITY TESTS

**Eligible Breeds & Registry:** Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event (An "event" is defined by an event number). Dogs requiring registry in Canine Partners must be spayed or neutered and are subject to a separate registration fee of \$19.00 to AKC.

**Tests & Titles:** Offered for all dogs, AKC registered, PAL, ILP or mixed breeds in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs over 12" must complete a course of 600 yards with 4 turns. Dogs under 12" must complete a 300 yard course with 4 turns. For complete rules and requirements, visit [akc.org](http://akc.org). Each dog which passes the course will receive an orange qualifying ribbon.

**CAT Title:** Three titles will be awarded to dogs that pass the Coursing Ability Test the required number of times. These are suffix titles that will appear on the dog's pedigree with a higher-level title superseding a lower-level title.

- 1) Coursing Ability (CA)-awarded to a dog that passes the coursing ability test 3 times under at least two different judges
- 2) Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA)-awarded to a dog that passes the Coursing Ability Test 10 times
- 3) Coursing Ability Excellent (CAX) - awarded to a dog that passes the Coursing Ability Test 25 times

What Must a Dog Do to Pass the CAT? The Coursing Ability Test (CAT) is a pass/fail test. During the test, the dog runs the course once, without any other dogs. Because safety is of the utmost importance, the CAT takes into consideration the individual dog pursuing qualification and therefore has two different course lengths to accommodate the type and size of the entrant. In either case, dogs will chase a lure made of plastic strips.

Dogs Less than 12" tall & "Flat-Faced" Dogs: Any entrant that is less than 12" tall at the withers and/or a brachycephalic shall run a 300 yard course with turns no more acute than 90 degrees. For a 300 yard course, the dog must complete the test in less than 1 minute.

Dogs more than 12" tall: Any entrant that is taller than 12" at the withers and not brachycephalic shall run a 600 yard course (or as close to 600 yards is possible) with turns no more acute than 90 degrees. For 600 yard course, a dog must complete the test in less than 2 minutes. If there is a question which course a dog should run, the judge will decide.

Shorter Distance For Veterans: Veteran dogs may be allowed to run 2/3 of the normal distance, at the handler's discretion. For the purpose of CAT tests, "veteran" dogs are defined as dogs over 7 years of age. The handler must declare prior to the start of the dog's run which distance the dog will run. This means that a veteran dog which would normally run the 300 yard course may run 200 yards and a veteran dog which would normally run 600 yard course may run 400 yards. Time to complete the course remains the same. Veteran dogs completing the shorter course will continue to earn legs toward the current CAT titles

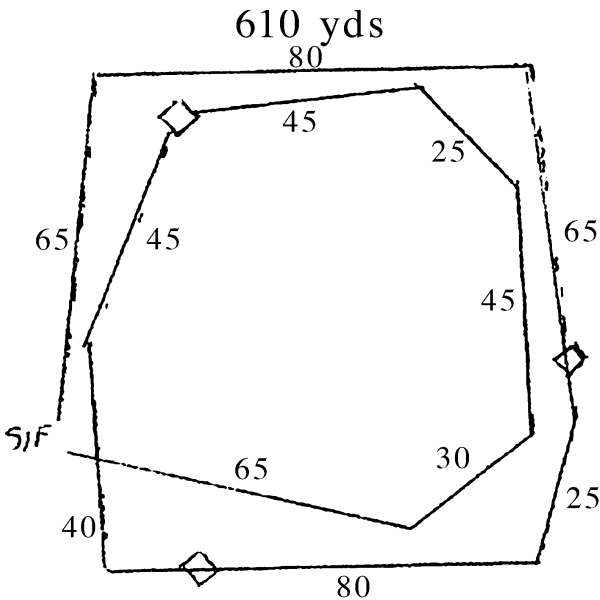
In order to pass, the dog must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption within the maximum amount of time for the course length. The time ends when the dog completes the course, not when the dog is leashed. A dog that relieves itself on the course shall fail the test.

The judge keeps the official time and is solely responsible for deciding the merits of the dog's performance

Ribbons & Prizes: A flat orange ribbon is awarded for successful completion of the CAT test.

### GENERAL RULES

- 1) All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the test.
- 2) Each entry will be examined and may be measured with a wicket at inspection. Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the inspection committee, an entry found to be lame, unfit to compete, or a female in season shall not be allowed to enter and entry fees shall be refunded.
- 3) Dogs are run "naked", i.e. without collars or harnesses. Muzzles are allowed. No pinch collars, electronic training collars or other such devises or flexi-leads are allowed on the event site.
- 4) Electronic continuous loop machines will be used. Lures will consist of white plastic bags.
- 5) The Field committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or Field conditions existing on the day of the test.
- 6) The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
- 7) There will be a \$5 fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course in progress (per AKC). The following actions may result a fine /or being excused for the event: unsportsmanlike conduct, not picking up after one's dog or litter in any area of the event.
- 8) No one is allowed on the field without the express permission of the Field Chairman except the appointed field committee
- 9) Incomplete, unsigned, conditional or entries without the proper fees will not be accepted. Owners alone are solely responsible for the accurateness of the information submitted on their dog's entry form.

# AKC Code of Sportsmanship

*PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.*

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
